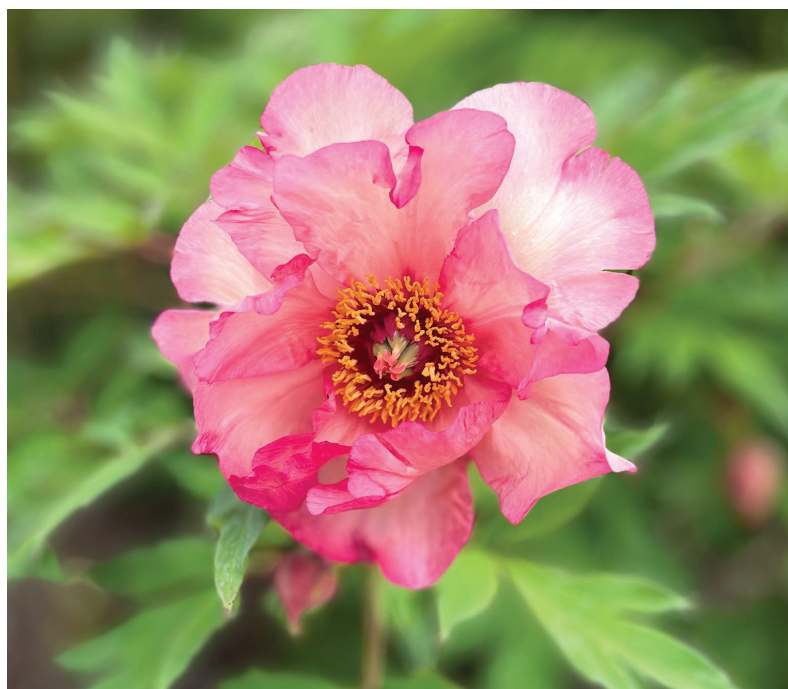


“WALK & TALK” AT COASTAL MAINE BOTANICAL GARDENS
